



## BDE itinerary

Approximate schedule:

### Day 1

Flight to Hurghada, transfer, accommodation on the boat, short briefeng.

### Day 2

Leaving to the sea, check dive in Abu Hashish.  
Second dive in Tobio Bay, night dive in Shaab Sheer.  
Night sailing to the marine park Brothers.

### Day 3

3-4 dives at the reef systems of Big Brother island.  
Night dives are forbidden in marine parks.

*There are 2 wrecks sitting from the North-West side of the Big Brother. One of them - Numidia, sank in 1901. Numidia lays vertically leaning onto the reef. Wreck diving starts at 25m, the ship goes down to 80m. The second wreck is Aida, it sank in 1957. The wreck is destroyed by storms and the only part still preserved is the back part of the ship which is situated at 30-60m depth.  
It is possible to visit the light house on the Big Brother. The light-house was built in 19 century by British.*

### Day 4

3-4 dives at the reef system of Small Brother island.  
Night dives are forbidden in marine parks.

*Small Brother is 3km away from the Big Brother. The walls are covered by soft corals, black corals and huge gorgonians. You can meet reef sharks, white-tip sharks, hammer-heads and moon-fish. Whale sharks often come to the Brothers.*

### Day 5

3 - 4 dives at the reef system of Daedalus island. Night dives are forbidden in marine parks.  
Night sailing to Marsa Alam area.

*Daedalus reef system is the farest reef from the shore. Its walls offer amazing scenary in the Red sea. You can meet hammer-neads, Grey reef sharks, Oceanic white tip sharks, manta rays and whale sharks.*

### Day 6

2 dives at Elphinstone reef system  
1 day and 1 night dive in the area of Safaga.

*Elphinstone is a famous reef covered with soft corals where you can meet Oceanic White Tips sharks and Grey Reef sharks throughout the whole year.  
Night dives are forbidden in marine parks.*

### Day 7

2 dives at the reef systems between Safaga and Hurghada.



If the weather allows it is possible to see Salem Express wreck.

*Wreck Salem Express is not far from Safaga. The ship sank in 1991 when sailing to Safaga from Saudi Arabia with 2000 people aboard. The wreck has enormous size and can be seen from the surface.*

Returning to the port of Hurghada.

Day 8

Transfer to the airport.
